NEW DIVISION DESCRIPTIONS AND RULES FOR 2024

GREEN AS GRASS DIVISION- may cross enter into ARHA classes for which they are eligible.

A Green as Grass (GAG) eligible exhibitor is a non-professional exhibitor of any age with no or very limited showing experience. A GAG exhibitor can never have trained horses, given lessons and/or clinics or assisted in the training of horses for remuneration. An exhibitor may enter GAG classes only if they are in their first, second or third year of showing in any national association, including different disciplines. A GAG exhibitor cannot have earned over \$500 combined money and/or acquired more than 50 points with any national breed/horse show organization. An exhibitor who has won a year-end title with any national organization is not eligible to enter GAG classes. A GAG exhibitor may not show in Walk-Trot Restricted Division classes at the same show but may enter any ILRHA class or ARHA class for which they are eligible (see ARHA Rules).

All horses in GAG must be ridden in legal ARHA tack. Horses may be ridden two-handed in a GAG class provided the exhibitor enters the class riding two-handed. **Alternating from one to two-handed and vice versa in the pen is a DQ.** No training equipment is allowed. Exhibitors must wear proper attire as described in the ARHA rulebook.

GAG division classes for the 2024 show year are: GAG Ranch Trail, GAG Ranch Boxing, GAG Horsemanship, GAG Conformation, GAG Showmanship, GAG Ranch Riding, and GAG Ranch Roping.

To be eligible for weekend circuit and year-end awards the exhibitor and horse owner must be ILRHA members and adhere to all ILRHA award rules. No ARHA membership is required and no Certificate of Eligibility for the horse is required unless cross-entering into the ARHA classes. ***In addition, to be eligible for weekend circuit awards, the horse/exhibitor combination must show in a minimum of one cattle class.***

WALK-TROT RESTRICTED DIVISION – Rider may not cross-enter into classes where a lope may be required, even if riding a different horse. Horse may be ridden by another rider in a non-restricted (w/t/l) division.

The purpose of this division is to encourage exhibitors to participate and experience show competition even if they or their horse are not ready to compete in classes that would require them to lope. **Except** for the **ILRHA Open Ranch Riding Walk Trot Jackpot** class, which is open to all exhibitors **except** those showing in this division, a **Walk-Trot Restricted Division (WTRD)** exhibitor may choose to ride in walk-trot only classes on a particular horse. Unless otherwise specified, both youth and adults may show in Walk-Trot Restricted Division classes. Once an exhibitor/horse combination shows in WTRD classes at a specific show, that exhibitor/horse combination may not show in any walk, trot, lope class at that show. An exhibitor in this class is prohibited from cross entering into another division in which a lope is an approved gait, even if riding a different horse. All Walk-Trot Restricted Division classes may be ridden two-handed provided the exhibitor enters the class riding two-handed. **Alternating from one to two-handed and vice versa in the pen is a DQ.** All horses in Walk-Trot Restricted Division classes must be shown in legal ARHA tack, and appropriate western attire as described in the ARHA rulebook.

To be eligible for weekend circuit or year-end awards the exhibitor and horse owner must be ILRHA members and adhere to all ILRHA award rules. No ARHA membership is required and no Certificate of Eligibility for the horse is required. Additionally, there is no requirement for the exhibitor/horse combination to show in one cattle class to be eligible for awards.

Walk-Trot Restricted Division classes for the 2024 show year are designated “**WTRD**” and include: **WTRD** Ranch Trail, **WTRD** Horsemanship, **WTRD** Conformation, **WTRD** Showmanship, and EITHER, **WTRD** 18 & Under, OR **WTRD** Adult Ranch Riding.
